Replicate the industrial vibe from some of the country's top hotels with the Grain scone from Brendan Ravenhill Studio in Los Angeles. Officially launched in October, the handmade swing-arm light is created using a wooden mold that imparts handsome woodgrain onto its aluminum surface. Ravenhill touts the design's ability to cozy up an open floor plan with ease. "It can break out a larger space into more intimate sections," he says.
